

## Fire Ban It is forbidden to light fires

The prohibition applies to lighting fires and barbecuing in woods and land outside cohesive buildings. There it is only allowed to grill at prepared barbecue places or places that are designed so that the danger of ignition and spread is low. So-called disposable grills or similar devices that provide heat dissipation directly to the ground are not allowed.

In the event of a fire ban, it is:

- allowed to barbecue on your own plot with coal / briquettes / gas on an appropriate grill.
- permitted to barbecue in specially prepared barbecue places in stone, concrete or the like. Temporarily arranged barbecue places that are made of rocks or logs do not meet the requirements for a safe barbecue area.
- allowed to use camping kitchens, storm kitchens and the like if placed on fireproof surfaces such as stone, gravel or sand.
- not allowed to use disposable grills because it is not a safe barbecue area.
- prohibited to use pyrotechnic equipment outdoors.
